1 MOSQUITO NET

Malaria is the biggest killer of children in sub-saharan Africa. Mosquito nets are key to defense against malaria and a huge life saver.



WARM BLANKET

In the high altitude areas of Kenya where temperatures are cold at night, a blanket will provide warmth to children and elderly brethren & sisters.



FRUIT TREE SEEDLINGS (20 AVOCADO OR MANGO)

A fruit tree will provide a good source of nutrition for a family as well as a potential source of income if fruit can be sold at a local market.



1 HYGIENE KIT FOR A FAMILY

These simple kits go a long way to preventing infectious disease and ensuring these children stay healthy. Kits consist of a wash bucket, soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, cloths, laundry soap & bag.



TEACHER'S KIT

Provide teacher's with the basics to aid in their teaching. Kits include pens, chalk, paper, scissors, books, teaching aids, etc.



MATTRESS & BEDDING

Many children sleep on dirt floors. These mattresses not only provide a good's night sleep but will protect them from the damp cold and help prevent parasitic infections.



SPORTS EQUIPMENT FOR KIDS (SOCCER BALL, SKIPPING ROPE, VOLLEYBALL ETC...)

AinA Children's Homes and Schools in Kenya, Uganda & India will be provided with some sporting equipment.



DESKS/CHAIRS

Fit out an AinA school classroom with desks and chairs to get children off the floor when doing their school work.



AGRICULTURAL TRAINING

Sponsor a local agricultural expert to visit an ecclesia and provide basic training on growing crops and raising animals.



NUTRITION DRINK FOR 30 CHILDREN FOR 6 MONTHS

These drinks will be provided 3 times a week at AinA schools in Kenya. This program is modelled after the successful recipe used in India for many years. Made from local ingredients, this drink provides protein, vitamins & nutrients lacking from the children's regular diet.



DAIRY COW

Provide an ongoing source of milk for children in AinA programs as a source of calcium.
