Nursery Schools are being operated in several Christadelphian halls across Kenya. AinA is supporting two of these nursery schools in the coastal region of Kenya (Mwando and Godo). Before these schools were started, children were walking up to 10 km to get to school. At nursery school age, this was taking them 3 hours each way. Because of these long distances, many children delayed their education until they were old enough to make the trek. Those critical first years of life were wasted. The importance of these schools cannot be overstated. The AinA nursery schools:

- Have a profoundly positive influence on the lives of young children. Research shows that in the first five years of life a child develops 90% of their adult-size brain. These schools provide a caring and stimulating environment for needy children who might not otherwise be able to go to school.
- Provide a small stipend for teachers & provide school materials to promote a positive learning environment.
- Provide a full nutrition & health program that supports development.
- Give each child a school uniform and shoes.
- Lay the foundation for the most important education of all - an understanding and appreciation of the gospel. Many students are Christadelphian children and the others, along with their parents, are encouraged to become involved in Sunday School and other activities run by the ecclesia.
- Provide a greatly appreciated service to the community; the schools are so popular that enrolment has had to be capped.

The Msamaria Mwema Academy Mwando (Mwando Good Samaritan School) runs from the Mwando Christadelphian Ecclesial Hall and supports about 100 children. There are 4 teachers and classes are from JK through Form 2. The Mwangaza wa Godo Nursery School (Godo School of Light Nursery) runs from the Godo Christadelphian Ecclesia Hall and supports about 60 children. There are 2 teachers. These schools are supported by ongoing sponsorship (\$30/month) and donations. Sponsors received regular updates, photographs and correspondence from the children and teachers at the school.
